### **Futurity Incentive Program Results**

The WCRHA Futurity Incentive Program began in June of this year with the intention of promoting the three-year old Non-pro Futurity horse and its rider within the West Coast Reining Horse Association community. WCRHA is the largest affiliate in the NRHA community, yet we have very few representatives exhibiting in the Non-pro Futurity in Oklahoma. Thirteen Non-pro riders participated in the program this year. Points were earned in the Futurities held at the Summer Rein, High Roller Reining Classic, and the WCRHA Year End shows. The top two placings in these events, as well as extra points earned from attending a schooling event, were tabulated to determine the winners.

Hearty congratulations to the winners and a huge thank you to all of the participants for taking part and supporting this innovative program. The top three point earners carried off beautiful crystal cups and "big" checks. First place went to Jennifer Gilliam on A Smart Gun. Britta Jacobsen on her Ms Benz earned the second place award, and Lauren Crivelli won third place with her Check Your Gun Lad.

The award money was generously sponsored by Geir and Jill Ramleth. Monetary payouts of \$3,000 to first place, \$2,000 to second place, and \$1,000 to third place will be presented at the 2014 NRHA Futurity show.


Slide for the Cure has raised over \$12,500 this year to




sored by Geir Ramleth. This opportunity program is so new your baby owners need to take a good look at this next year.


