The WCRHA Futurity Incentive Program began in June of this year with the intention of promoting the three-year old Non-pro Futurity horse and its rider within the West Coast Reining Horse Association community. WCRHA is the largest affiliate in the NRHA community, yet we have very few representatives exhibiting in the Non-pro Futurity in Oklahoma. Thirteen Non-pro riders participated in the program this year. Points were earned in the Futurities held at the Summer Rein, High Roller Reining Classic, and the WCRHA Year End shows. The top two placings in these events, as well as extra points earned from attending a schooling event, were tabulated to determine the winners.

Hearty congratulations to the winners and a huge thank you to all of the participants for taking part and supporting this innovative program. The top three point earners carried off beautiful crystal cups and "big" checks. First place went to Jennifer Gilliam on A Smart Gun. Britta Jacobsen on her Ms Benz earned the second place award, and Lauren Crivelli won third place with her Check Your Gun Lad.

The award money was generously sponsored by Geir and Jill Ramleth. Monetary payouts of \$3,000 to first place, \$2,000 to second place, and \$1,000 to third place will be presented at the 2014 NRHA Futurity show.

A special thank you is extended to Geir & Jill Ramleth, Mike & Barbi Boyle, David Hanson, and Terry Holland for their work on this new program. **Best of luck to everyone who will be showing their three-year old at the Futurity show in November!**

While the early part of the week was a bit warm, I think all and all the weather was very good and our friends from the rainy northwest enjoyed the abundant sunshine.

The week started out with some of the Open classes and ended with the NRHA Green Reiner One and Two. And in between, there were all the NWAFF and ancillary classes. Most of the classes were very big. The Rookie Classes alone had over 70 exhibitors entered into them. There were some great scores in all classes. The youth classes had over 35 entries this year.

Then there were the aged events. We had, I believe, one of the largest Futurities and Derbies ever. There were nearly 30 entries in the Non-pro Derby alone. We also had guest lecturers give us talks on colic as well as horse anatomy. We are thankful to the veterinarians who took time out of their busy days to come and share their knowledge and educate us. We will not soon forget Slide Zone being all painted up for our horse anatomy lesson.

New for this year was the Futurity Incentive Program. This program was fully sponsored by Geir and Jill Ramleth. Thank you Geir and Jill for your ongoing support and commitment to the sport of Reining as well as WCRHA.

It was also an amazing year for the "Slide for the Cure." Melynda Silvashy retooled the event this year, including a new benefactor, the Oregon Health and Science University (OSHU) and the Knight Cancer Institute. Phil Knight, co-founder of the Nike shoe company, announced in September that he and his wife Penny would donate 500 million dollars to OSHU if the Knight Cancer Institute could raise an additional \$500 million. This money would be going to cancer research into early detection and treatment.

It is my understanding that the goal is 80% met as of this date. Thank you Melynda for all your hard work in putting together and running this amazing event.
